Session	Aims	Content
1 16 th September	To look at artists who painted St. Michael's Mount, Mounts Bay, Marazion, Land's End and Sennen from the 19 th century to the present day.	Artists who first came to paint Cornwall in particular St. Michael's Mount and Land's End including J.M.W. Turner, William Daniell, Clarkson Stansfield, and John Brett. We then look at 20 th century artists who captured Mount's Bay round to Sennen and Cape Cornwall including Alfred Wallis, Terrick Williams, Laura Knight, June Miles, John Miller, Martina Thomas and Paul Lewin amongst others.
2 23rd September	To look at artists who painted around Falmouth, the Roseland, Mevagissey, Fowey, Polperro and Looe.	Artists of Falmouth and the Roseland, Fowey, Polperro: Turner, William Daniell, Clarkson Stansfield, C.N.Hemy, H.S. Tuke, W.A. Ingram, Arthur Wilde Parsons, Arthur Briscoe, Claude Rowbotham, Frank Brangwyn, Charles Pears, Oska Kokoschka, Francis Hewlett, Chris Insoll, Andrew Tozer, and Jamie Medlin.
3 30 September	To look at Artists who painted around Newlyn, Mousehole and Lamorna from the 19 th Century to the present day.	Artists of Newlyn, Mousehole, Lamorna: Henry Martin, Caroline Gotch, Stanhope Forbes, Walter Langley, Harold Harvey, Lamorna Birch, Charles Simpson, Alfred Munnings, Harold Knight, Laura Knight, Christopher Wood, Richard Eurich, Jack Pender, Joan Gillchrest, Michael Praed, Neil Pinkett and Michael Porter amongst others.
4 7 th October	To look at artists who painted on the Lizard in the mid-19 th century through to the present day.	Artists of The Lizard: Thomas Hart, Montague Hart, Tracy Dyke Hart, William Cassley, John Brett, John Platt, John Tunnard, Peter Lanyon, Jonathan Coudrille, Andrew Giddens, Vince Tutton, Martin Grimshaw, Neil Canning, Heather Howe, Janet Judge amongst others.
5 14 th October	To look at artists who came to St. Ives in the 1890s and founded a marine art colony there up to the 1930s.	Artists in St. Ives, Hayle and Godrevy Part 1: Including Julius Olsson, Louise Grier, Arnesby Brown, Algernon Talmage, Mary MacCrossan, John Anthony Park, Richard Hayle Lever, Terrick Williams, Franz Müller-Grossen, Edmund Fuller and Thomas Maidment.
6 21st October	Look at the modern and naïve artists who painted in St. Ives and beyond from the 1930s to the present day.	Artists of St. Ives Part 2: Modern and naïve artists from Alfred Wallis, Christopher Wood, Ben Nicholson, Winifred Nicholson to contemporary artists such as Sax Impey, Eric Ward, and Jenny Shaw Browne amongst others.
7 4 th November	Look at artists who painted Perranporth, Newquay, Padstow, Boscastle, Tintagel, and Bude.	Artists of the North Coast: Including J.M.W. Turner, J.W. Inchbold, Arthur Wilde Parsons, Charles Ginner, Sarah Adams, Jeremy Gardiner, Saul Cathcart amongst others.
