7. 6 th Nov	To look at the RPCS Tuke collection now part of Falmouth Art Gallery's collection.	The RCPS Tuke Collection – became part of Falmouth Art Gallery's collection in 2016 . 279 works included by Henry Scott Tuke (1858 – 1929) from his teenage years to the last years of his life.
